Directions:

By car from Manhattan: Cross either the Manhattan or Brooklyn Bridges to Flatbush Avenue, follow Flatbush through downtown Brooklyn and Park Slope, across Grand Army Plaza and through Flatbush itself. Turn LEFT onto Clarendon Road (4 miles from

the Manhattan Bridge) and follow Clarendon to East 59th Street (2 miles). The Wyckoff House is on the right, in M. Fidler-Wyckoff House Park.

By public transportation from Manhattan: Take the #2 or #5 train to Newkirk Avenue in Brooklyn. (If the #5 is not running to Brooklyn, take the #4 to Nevins Street and switch to the #2.) Exit the station and proceed to the southwest corner of Nostrand Avenue and Avenue D to change to the B8 bus. Take the B8 eastbound, toward King's Highway. Exit the bus at Beverley Road and East 59th Street. Walk one block south on East 59th Street to M. Fidler-Wyckoff House Park.
