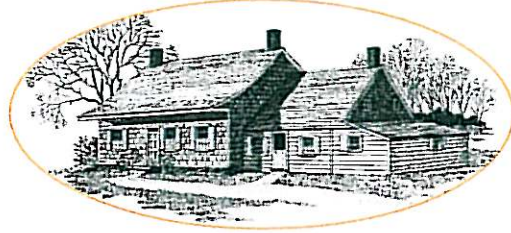


Chaperone Job Description



Welcome to the Wyckoff Farmhouse Museum. Chaperons have a very important role. While an educator will meet your group and lead your program, we need your help in moving the group and keeping the students on task so the visit will run smoothly!

One the day of the trip:



The teacher may assign you to a group. Make sure your students stay on task and assist them with all activities,



Dress comfortably;



If you are eating lunch onsite, bring a bag lunch with your name on it;



Monitor your group as they use the restroom and at lunch;



Stay towards the back of the group and account for all students;



Escort students to restroom during the program, if needed;



Encourage students to pay attention to the educator.



Stay with the group at all times; and



Have fun!

For each of the following activities, here is how you can help your group:

Worksheet Activities/Object Observations

- Tell them to read the directions aloud.
- Make sure they assign one – two people to complete the worksheet.
- If they have objects, have them examine each.
- Remind them to complete their worksheet.
- They should select two people to present their ideas to the class.

- Make sure students stay on task.
- When applicable, assist them with the activity.
