GROUP SIZE

Minimum: 6 people

PROGRAM LENGTH

1–2 hours, depending on program and group size.

FEEES

K–12 Student Groups:

\$180 flat fee for up to 30 students and 5 chaperones.

College Student and Senior Groups:

\$190 flat fee per group of up to 30 people

Adult Groups:

\$240 flat fee per group of up to 30 people
